

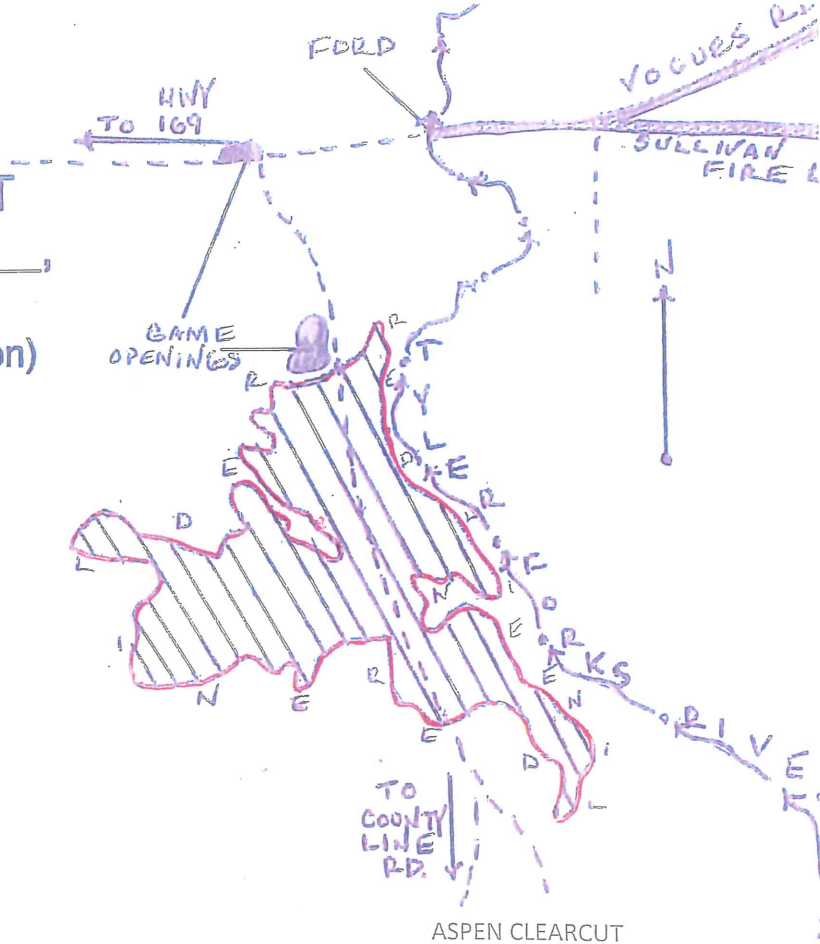

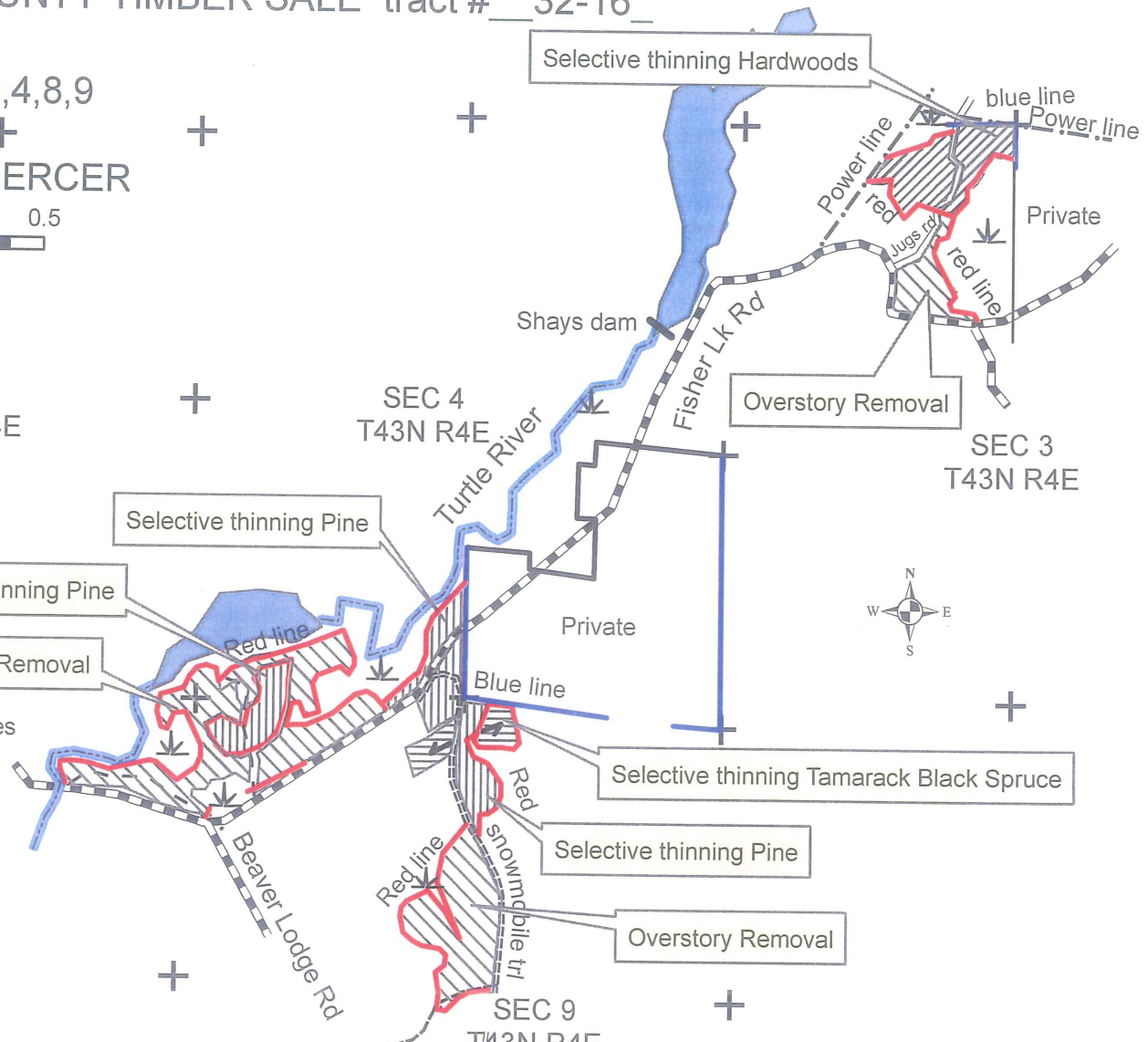

All areas: No slash to be left over Blue Line. Eliminate rutting, Do not operate equipment within 15 feet of wetlands unless ground is frozen. Do not cut trees marked with green paint. Protect residual trees.

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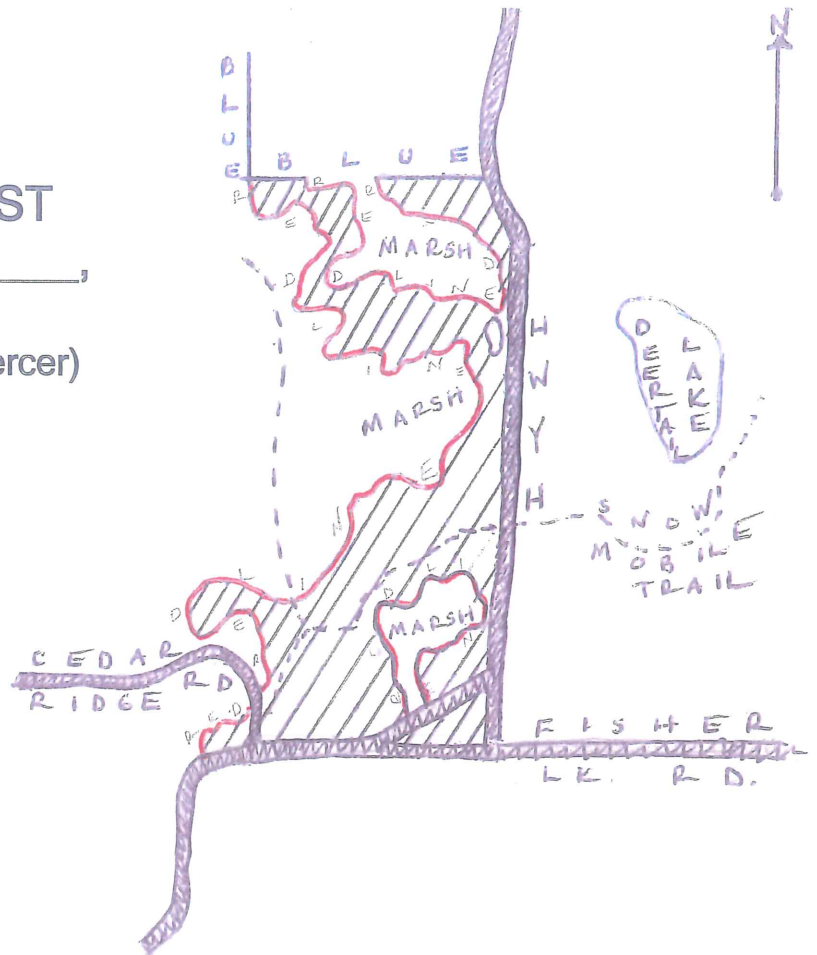
