Northern Hardwood Single tree selection (51 hatched acres): Cut all trees marked with orange paint, Ironwood, all Balsam fir and aspen. There is no harvest activity in this stand from April 1 to July 1 to protect residual stems from damage. Leave snags and den trees when safe to do so. Do not cut any hemlock, cedar, or white or red pine.

Coppice with standards (62 cross hatched acres): Leave all trees marked with green/teal paint, white and red pine, cedar, and hemlock; harvest everything else.

Utilize sawlogs to a 10" top diameter and pulpwood to a 4" top diameter. Cut all trees that will yield one 100-inch pulp stick. Sale boundaries are marked with red and blue paint.
