

Unit 1 - Aspen Coppice Harvest (23 ac.) Cut all trees 2" and larger except oak, cedar, hemlock, tamarack, spruce, and pine. Utilize pulpwood to a 4" minimum top diameter.

Unit 2 - Regeneration Harvest (19 ac.) Cut all trees with one (1) or more merchantable pulpwood sticks. Leave all oak, cedar, hemlock, tamarack, spruce, & pine. Utilize pulpwood to a 4" minimum top diameter.

In both units, leave all snags standing where safely possible. Ensure soils are adequately dry or frozen to avoid rutting. No new road construction without permission of sale administrator. No decking along Ruks Road or Old 10 without permission of Town of Saxon. Sale boundaries are blue paint lines and ash swamps.
