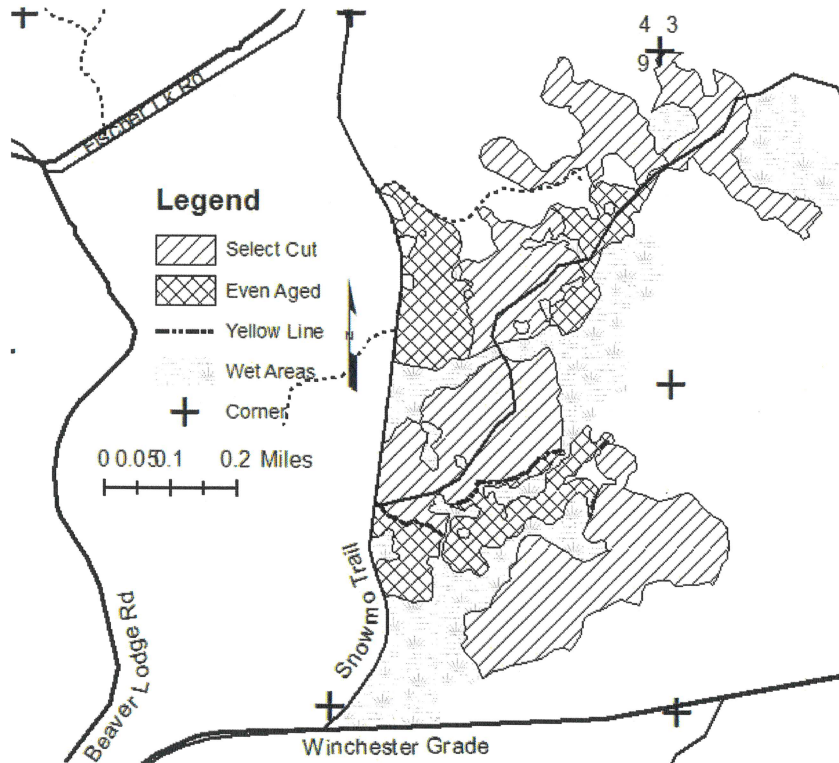

HARVEST SPECIFICATIONS

Northern Hardwood Select Cut (107 acres): Cut all trees marked with orange paint, Ironwood, aspen and all Balsam fir 2" and greater. Leave dead snags and den trees. Do not cut any red and white pine, oak, yellow birch, cedar, and hemlock.

Clearcut (40 acres): Harvesting all trees including ironwood and all balsam fir 2" and greater. Do not harvest any red and white pine, oak, yellow birch, cedar, and hemlock. Leave all dead snags and den trees.

Utilize sawlogs to a 10" top diameter and pulpwood to a 4" top diameter. Utilize all designated trees that will yield one 100-inch pulp stick. Sale boundaries are marked with red and yellow. Strictly follow Wisconsin Best Management Practices for water quality. Do not fall trees in or create skid trails over large areas of advanced regeneration or in wet areas. Retain all trees marked red and yellow. Harvest only on frozen ground to protect the soil from rutting, compaction and to protect the residual stems from damage. Yellow lines where established to differentiate between small areas of the clearcut and the selection harvest. "Logging Ahead" and "Trucks Hauling" signs will be placed on the Winchester Grade Rd, Fisher Lake Rd. (Railroad Grade/Beaver Lake Rd) and the snowmobile/ATV/UTV trails any time there is harvesting occurring. All woods roads that are used for this sale will be back bladed upon sale completion and returned to their original condition. Chapter 30 permit maybe required.

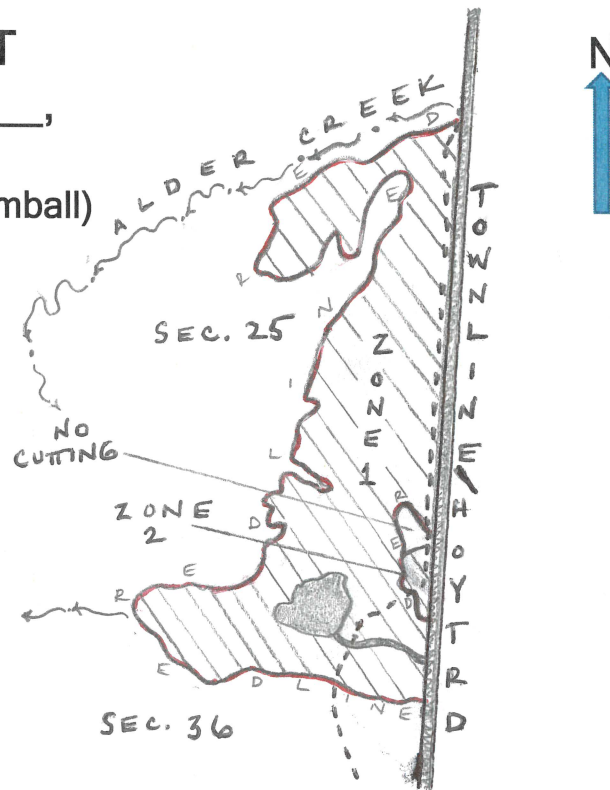
