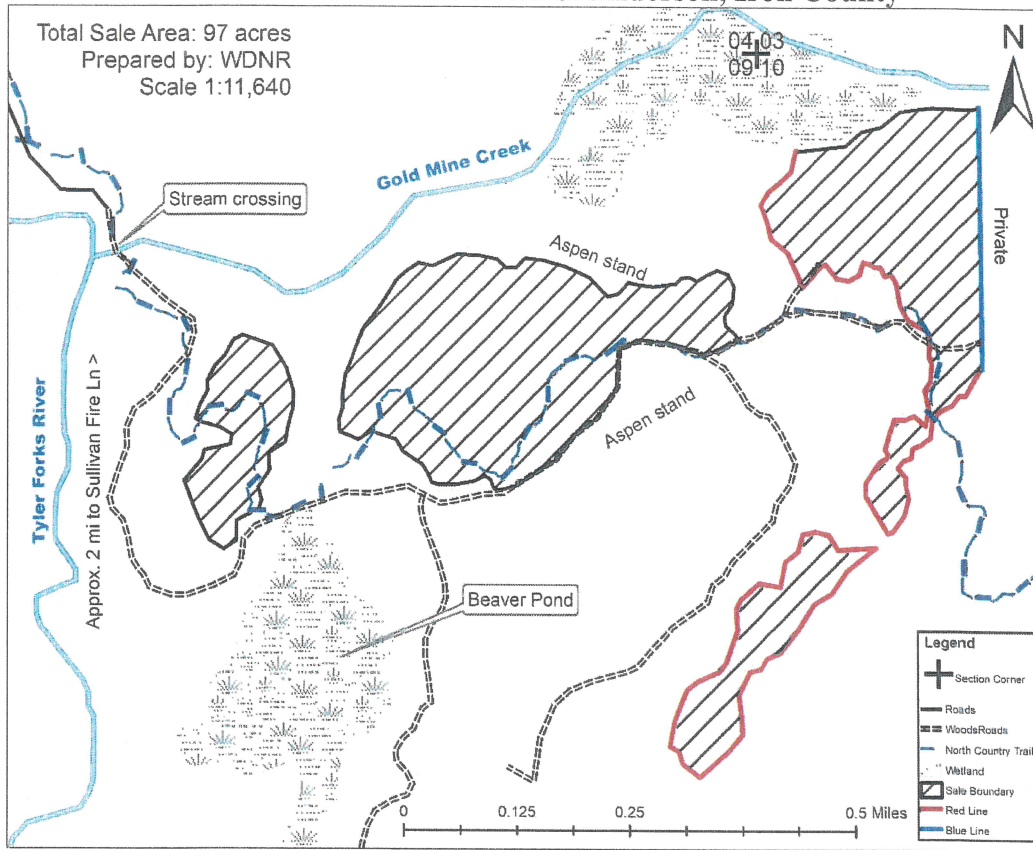


**Iron County Forest**

**HARVEST SPECIFICATIONS**

**Single Tree Selection/Group Selection:** Cut all trees marked with orange paint and all aspen, ironwood, and balsam fir greater than 2" DBH. Leave all standing dead snags and den trees when safe to do so. Do not cut any pine, white cedar, elm, or red oak. Areas of concentrated ironwood trees that are sub-merchantable should be driven over to crush the stems to reduce the chance of them re-sprouting.

Utilize sawlogs to a 10" top diameter and pulpwood to a 4" top diameter. Sale boundaries are either marked with red paint, blue paint, end at steep cliff drop-offs, or border aspen stands and open marshland. Strictly follow all Wisconsin Best Management Practices for water quality. Ensure soil is adequately dry or frozen to avoid rutting, soil compaction, and impact to ephemeral ponds. Retain all trees along the North Country Trail marked with a blue blaze and minimize crossings over the trail. Do not fell trees in or create skid trails in wet areas or across the blue property line.

All slash will be evenly dispersed throughout sale area. No slash shall be left across sale boundaries. Leave unmerchantable logs where they're cut to remain as coarse woody debris (ex: large diameter, hollow or rotten logs with no value). All woods roads that are used for this sale will be back bladed upon sale completion. Iron County Forestry will install a bridge over Gold Mine Creek summer 2021. **No harvesting between April 1 and July 1! Harvest on dry or frozen ground only!**

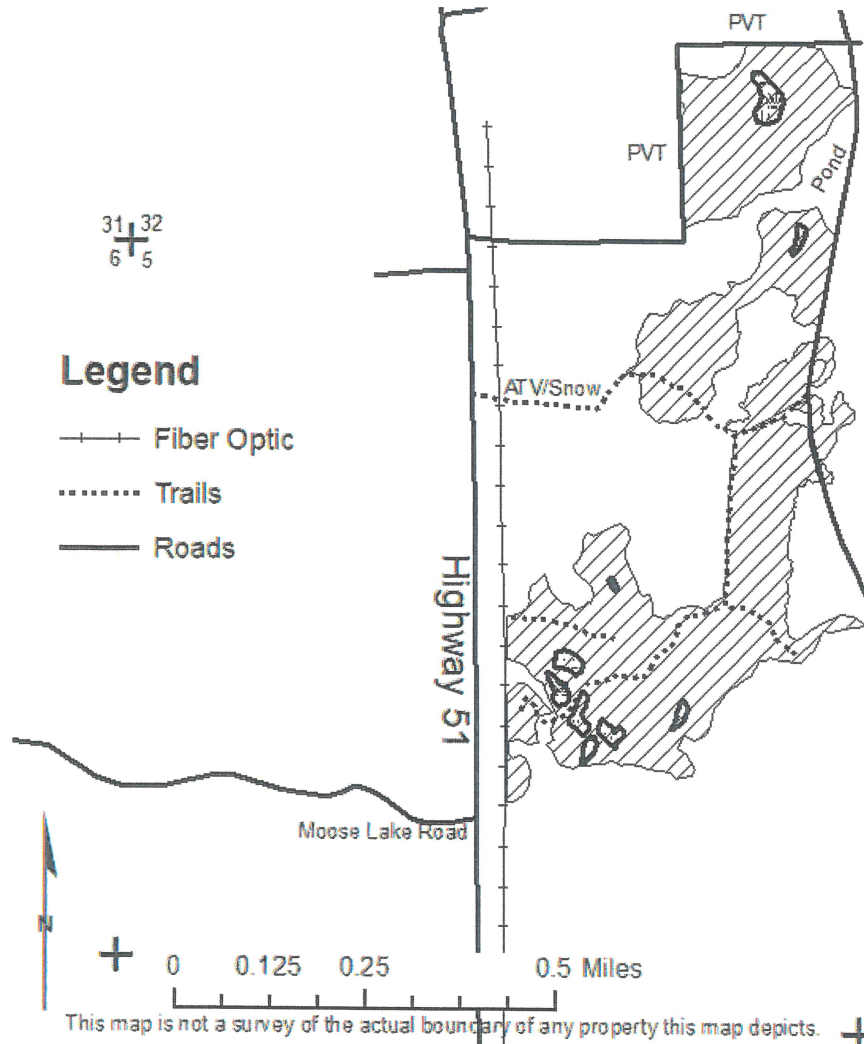

**Harvest Specifications:** Sale boundary and larger interior wetlands are delineated with red paint. Private lands are marked with blue paint. Cut and utilize all orange marked trees. Cut and utilize all aspen, balsam fir, and spruce that will yield at least one pulp stick across entire sale and all timber types. Some spruce are marked with orange paint but cut all spruce.

**General Cutting Restrictions:** No slash shall be left lying over the blue line. Excessive rutting or excessive damage to residual trees shall result in suspension of logging activity. The sale must be cut progressively. Protect survey markers from damage. New road construction will require Forest Administrator approval. No harvest activity between 15 March and 1 July. Follow all Wisconsin BMPs to protect water and soil quality.

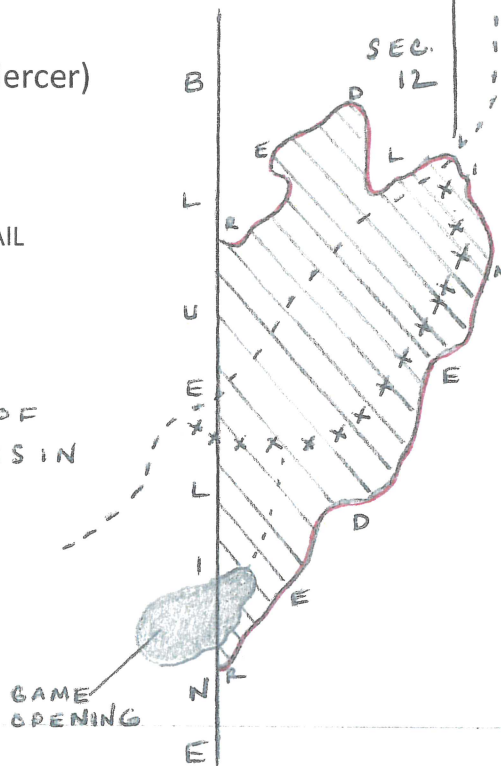

Harvest Specifications: Cut all marked pine, and all aspen, mixed hardwood, spruce, and balsam fir that contain a 1-100" pulpstick. No cutting of elm, ash, or cedar. Utilize pulpwood to a 4" top diameter sawlogs to a 10" top diameter. All decked red pine will be removed within 21 days due to possible pine beetle borer infestation. Care should be taken during harvesting to minimize and detrimental effects to the soil not only in sale but along the cross-country ski trail. Any areas crossed with machinery along trail will need to be fixed before sale completion. Follow all BMP's. Sale will be free of litter at all times. All slash will remain within cutting area and off the snowmobile trail and cross-country ski trail. **No cutting from December 1<sup>st</sup> to April 1<sup>st</sup>.**

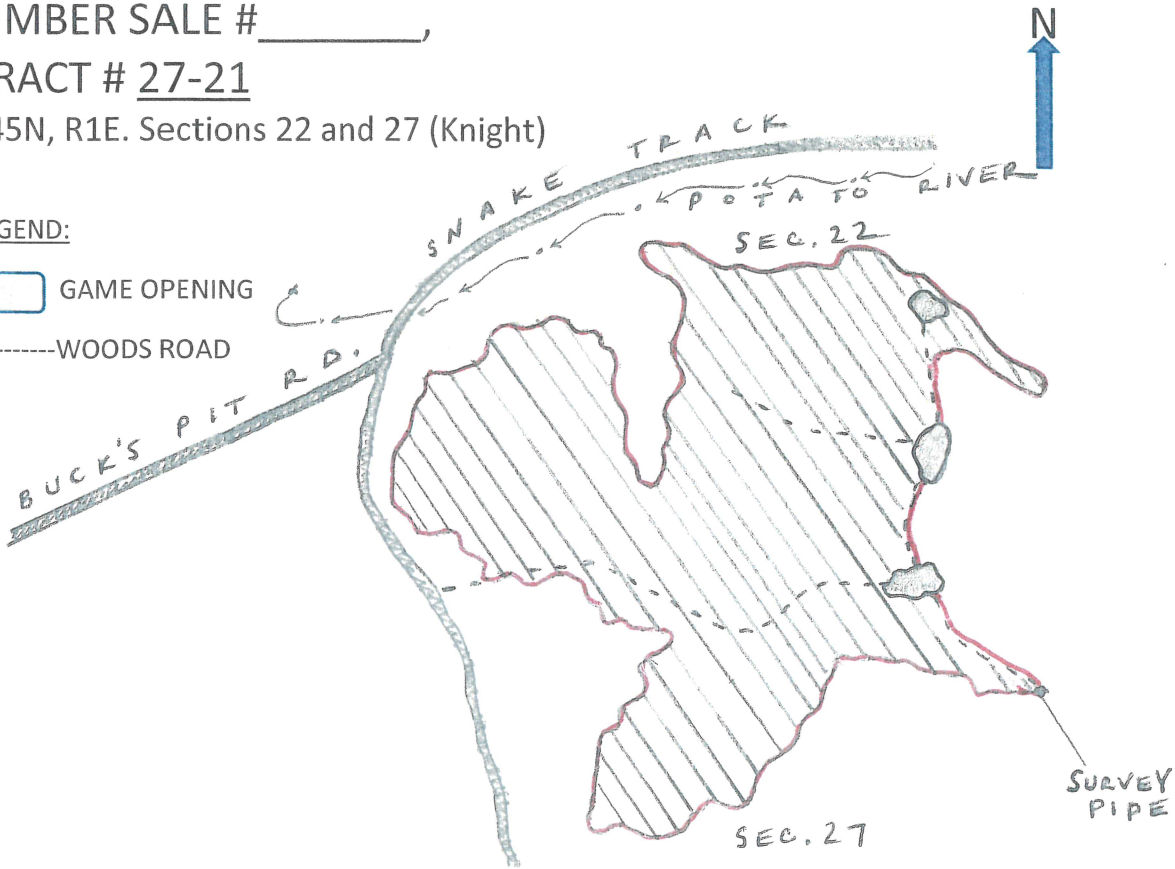

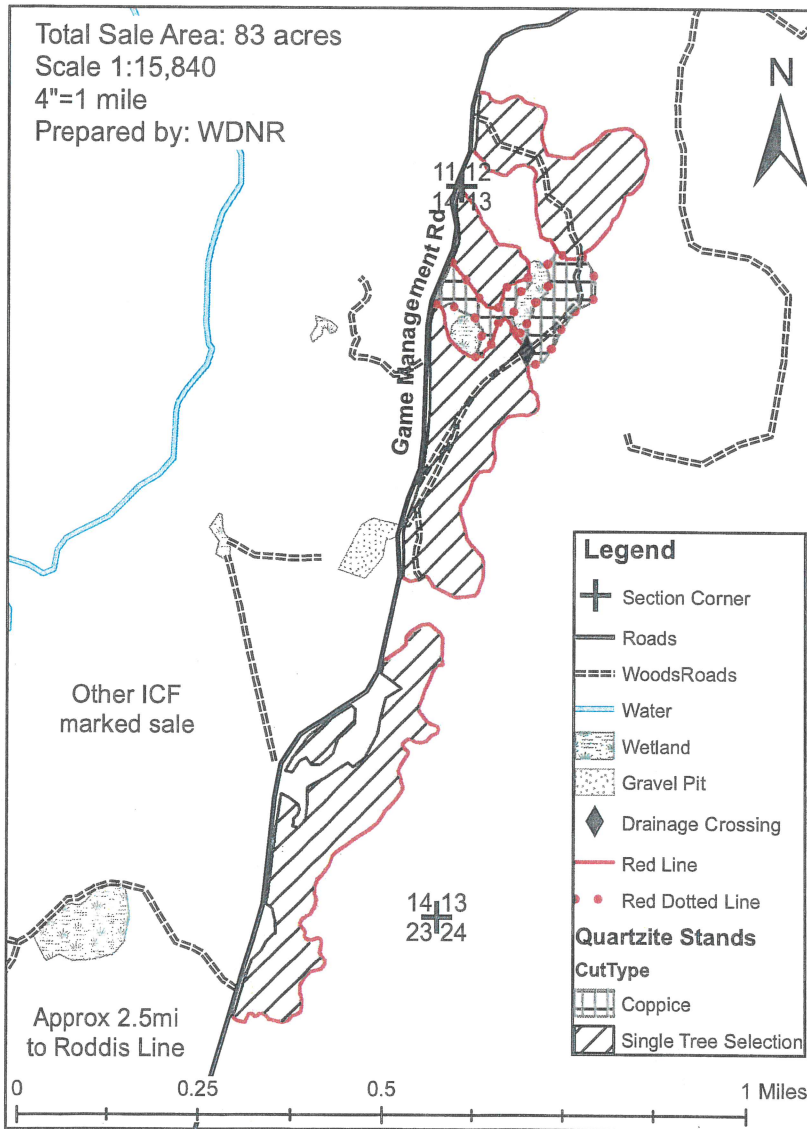

**Single Tree Selection:** Cut all aspen, balsam fir, and trees marked with orange paint. Leave all standing dead snags and den trees when safe to do so. Do not cut any oak, pine, hemlock, cedar, or american elm.

Utilize sawlogs to a 10" top diameter and pulpwood to a 4" top diameter. Sale boundaries are marked with a solid red paint line, a dotted red paint line, wildlife openings, and Game Management Rd. Strictly follow all Wisconsin Best Management Practices for water quality. Ensure soil is adequately dry or frozen to avoid soil compaction and rutting. All slash shall be evenly dispersed throughout the sale area. No slash shall be left across sale boundaries or in wildlife openings. 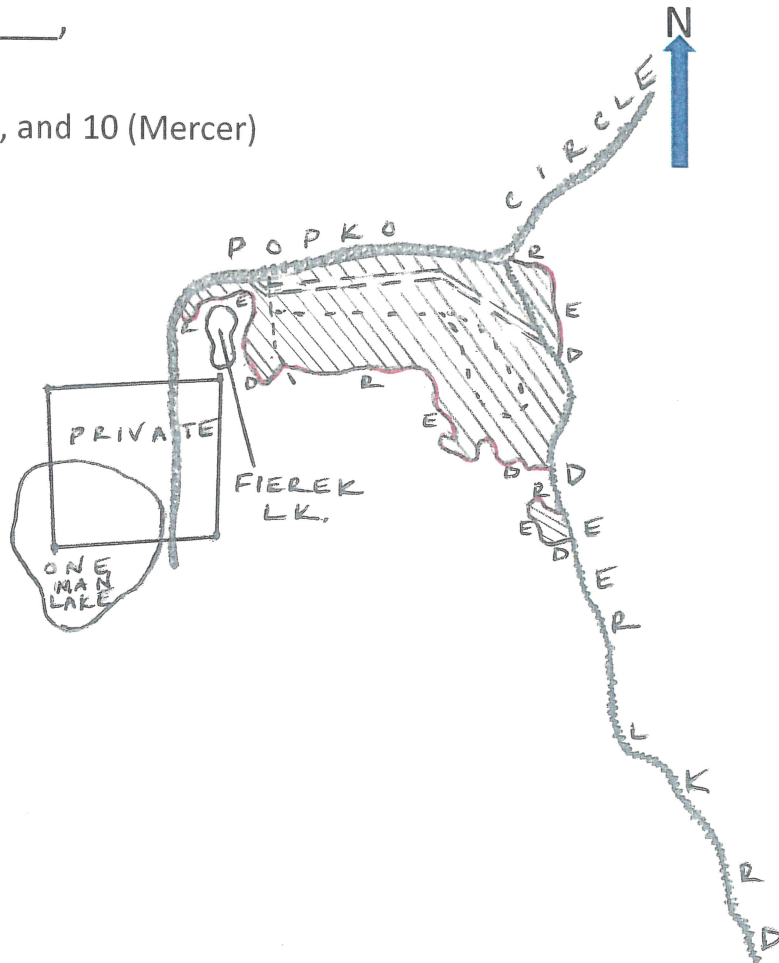
