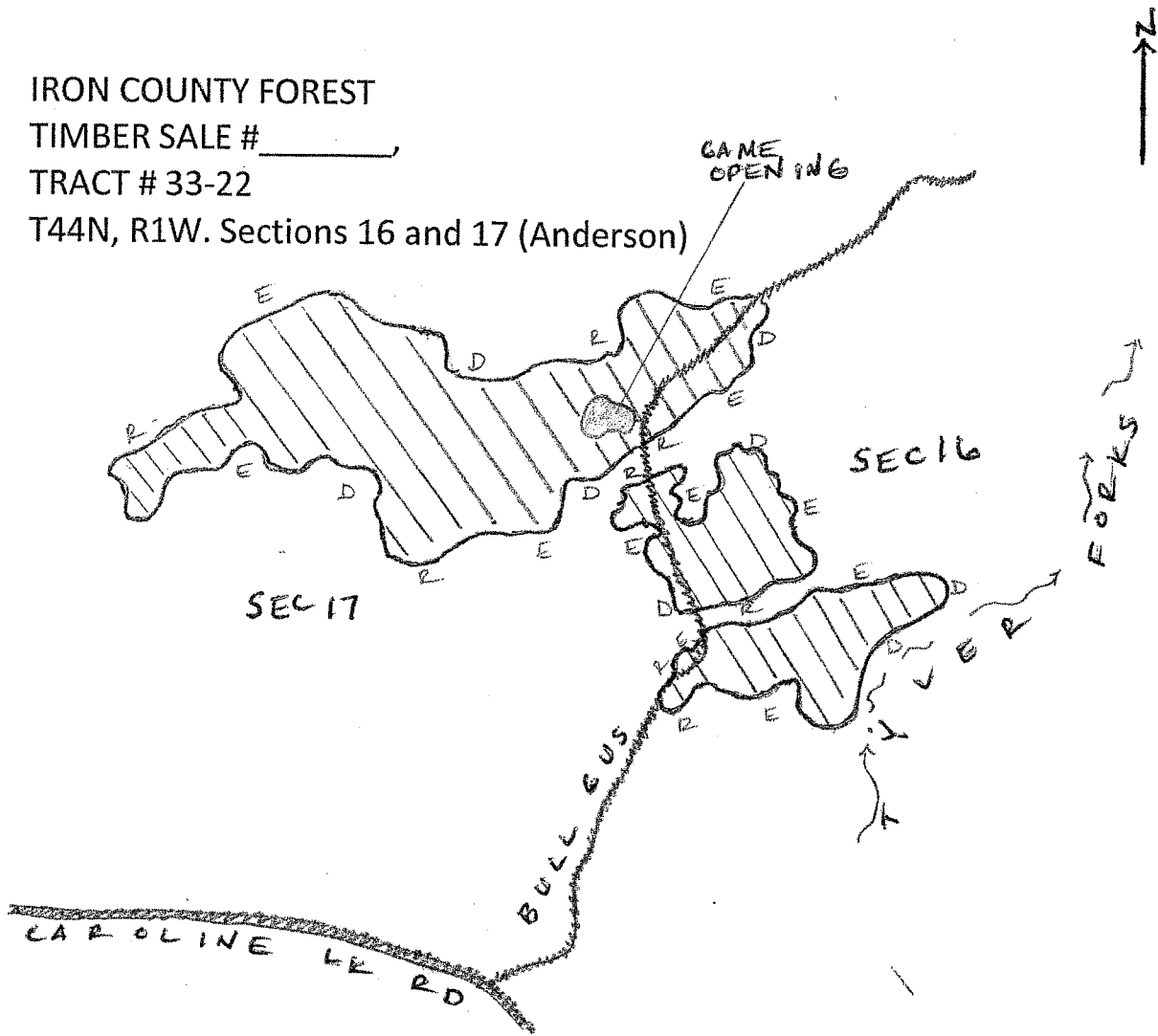

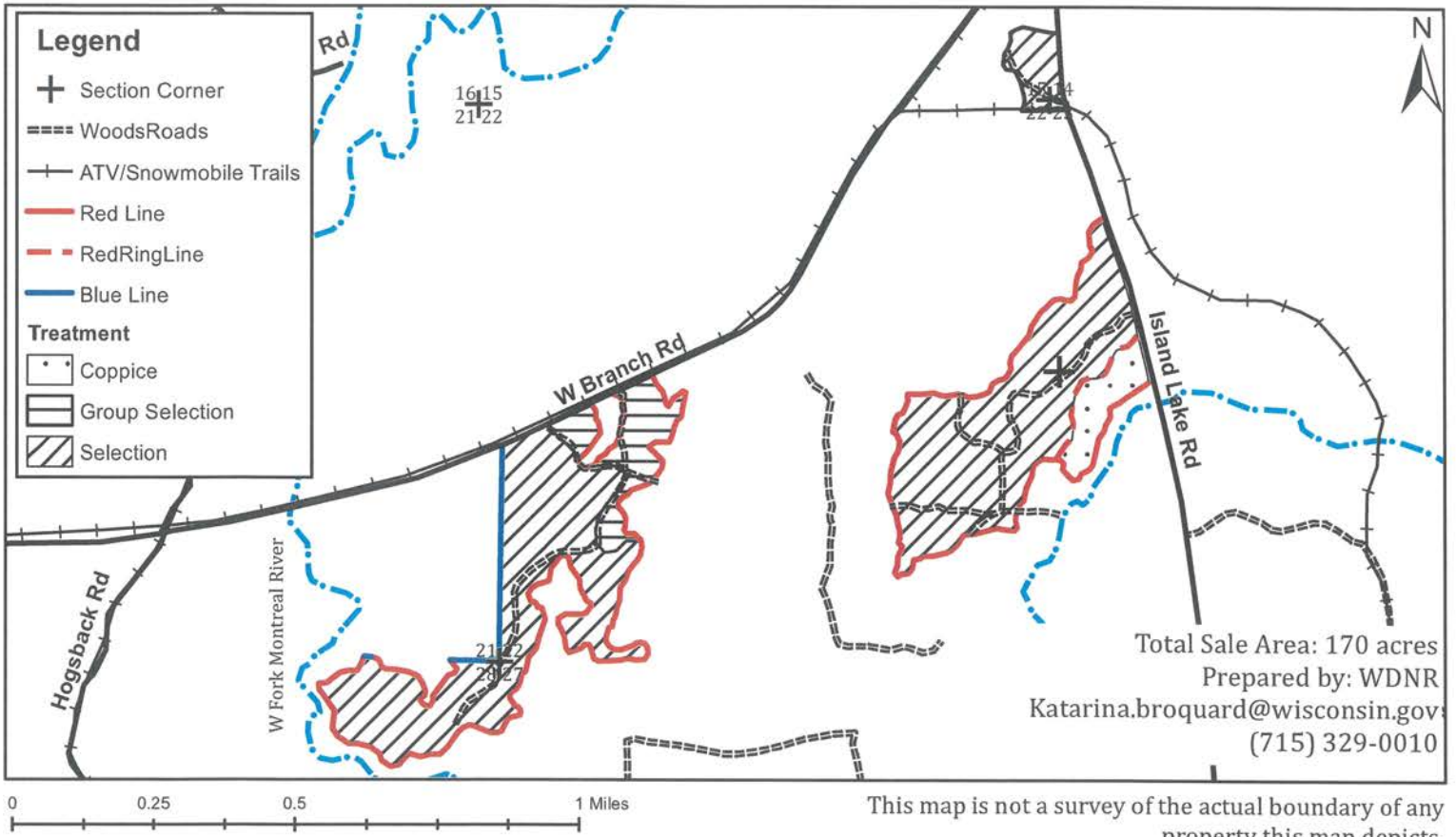

No cutting of ash, elm, oak, cedar, hemlock, or pine. Care should be taken during harvesting to minimize any detrimental effects to the soil. Follow all BMP's. Boundary lines are red lines. Single Tree Selection: (144acres) Cut all trees marked with orange paint. Avoid operating in areas of dense advanced regeneration. Prioritize ironwood and balsam when cutting new trails and operational trees.

Group Selection: (16acres) Harvest all orange marked trees and cut or crush all submerchantable stems within marked gaps. Do not harvest any american elm, red oak, white or yellow birch, spruce, hemlock, cedar, or white pine.

Coppice: (10acres) Harvest all merchantable hardwoods and balsam fir. Do not harvest any aspen larger than 16" dbh, american elm, red oak, or any conifer except balsam.

Leave all standing dead snags and den trees when safe to do so. Utilize sawlogs to a 10" top diameter and pulpwood to a 4" top diameter. Sale boundaries are marked with a red dot line, blue property line, or border Island Lake and West Branch Roads. The boundary between treatments on the east side is trees marked with a red ring.

Strictly follow all Wisconsin Best Management Practices for water quality. Woods roads must be snow-covered and adequately frozen before harvesting or building new roads due to invasive species present. All slash shall be evenly dispersed throughout the sale area. Leave unmerchantable logs where they are cut to remain as coarse woody debris (ex: large diameter, split, hollow, or rotten logs with no value).

All woods roads that are used for this sale will be back bladed upon sale completion. All new haul roads must be approved by sale administrator. No harvesting during spring breakup April 1- June 30 unless approved by the sale administrator.

Harvest Specifications

Single Tree Selection (70 acres)

Harvest all trees marked with orange paint and all aspen and ironwood with at least one 100" pulp stick. Sale boundary is marked with red lines.

Aspen Coppice (55 acres)

Harvest all aspen, mixed hardwood species except white birch and red oak, all white spruce, and all balsam fir with at least one 100" pulp stick. Do not harvest white birch, red oak, hemlock, black spruce, tamarack, cedar, or pine. Sale boundary is marked with two red dots.

Overstory Removal (52 acres)

Harvest all mixed hardwood species except yellow birch and red oak, all aspen, ironwood, white spruce, and balsam fir with at least one 100" pulp stick. Do not harvest yellow birch, red oak, hemlock, black spruce, tamarack, cedar, or pine. Sale boundary is marked with two red dots.
